Friday Nov 18th

Commences with fine breezes from W.S.W. shook out reef from fore & main topsails, middle parts light winds from old set top gallant sail at 10 AM heading S by E all sail out so ends this day. Course W by N.
Lat by Obs 53° 34' Lon by Obs 80° 15' 163

Saturday Nov 19th

Commences with strong breezes from N.W. at 2 AM Clewed down double reefed, took in fore & main topsail. At 8 AM main sail, at 11 P.M. set fore & main topsail, at 12 noon ship heading N.W. by N. at 4 set fore & main sail, at 7 give her single reefed topsails & spanker, latter parts strong breezes, so ends this day. Course N.W. by W.
Lat by Obs 53° 29' Lon by Obs 104

Sunday Nov 20

Commences with fine breezes from W.S.W. at 3 P.M. give her whole topsails, and top gallant sail at 11 Clewed down double reefed, at 9 took in fore & main sail at daylight made sail wore ship to the N.W. latter parts squally, so ends this day.

Monday Nov 21st

Commences with moderate weather shook out reefs & set top gallant sail, at 4 P.M. double reefed, took in fore & main sail 2 AM wore too at daylight give her close reefed topsails latter parts fine breezes, steering N.W. go it George so ends this day. Course N.W.
Lat by Obs 52° 22' Lon 166

Tuesday Nov 22nd

Commences with fine breezes from W.S.W. steering N.W. by N. give her single reefed topsails, at 8 P.M. double reefed, took in fore, middle parts squally at 4 AM broke out main hatchway for water heating N. latter parts moderate so ends this day. Course N by W. Lat by Obs Lon 167

Wednesday Nov 23rd

Commences with moderate weather & winds from W.S.W. heading N with single reefed topsails

at 7 double reefed took in fore middle parts squally heading S.W. latter parts moderate shook out reefs from main topsail set top gallant sail so ends this day. Course S.W. by S.

Thursday Nov 24th

Commences with light winds from W. took a to N.W. at 4 P.M. set fore top mast sail steering N.W. by N. middle parts light winds from W.S.W. at 7 took in stoppage sail, braced yards latter parts same so ends this day. Course N.W. Lat by Obs 49° 8' Lon 169

Friday Nov 25th

Commences with fine breezes from N.W. at 8 square yards set S. sail, middle parts fine breezes from N.W. latter parts squally, the watch employed fitting fore top gallant rigging & sending the mast aloft so ends this day. Course N.W.
Lat by Obs Lon 170

Saturday Nov 26th

Commences with light winds from W.S.W. the watch employed in fitting fore top mast cross trees & top gallant yards at 5 P.M. sent yards aloft middle parts light winds at 7 AM watch fitting main top gallant rigging, sent mast & yards aloft sent fore & main top gallant sail, so ends this day. Course N.W. Lat by Obs 44° 01' Lon 171

Sunday Nov 27th

Commences with fine breezes from W.S.W. broke out hatchway for salt, middle parts same & latter parts same so ends this day. Course N.
Lat by Obs 42° 18' Lon by Obs 172

Monday Nov 28th

Commences with fine breezes from W. sand fine backing middle parts heavy with rain at 5 broke out & clear sky, fore & royal rigging at 7 the watch below so ends this day fine weather. Course S.W. Lat by Obs 37° 14' Lon 173

Tuesday Nov 29th

Commences with fine weather all hands employed in getting royal masts aloft & fly fore boom out at 5 P.M. finished middle parts fine & clear at daylight wind
