the coast at 3 PM finished stowing, middle  
parts fine, at day light washed off latter  
parts fine, fitted fore & main topsails, scraped  
waist &c so ends this day Lat Lon 189

Thursday Dec 15<sup>th</sup>

Commences with fine breezes from S.E., all  
hands employed in scraping & painting  
bent, fore & main topsails & fore sail, middle  
parts fine & clear so ends this latter parts  
same finished painting &c so ends this day  
Lat 29° 39' Lon 190

Friday Dec 16<sup>th</sup>

Commences with fine weather all hands  
employed in fitting rigging bent, fore  
fly, fore & fore topmast stay sail tarring  
down &c middle parts strong breezes from  
E.S.E. Latter parts same all hands employed  
so ends this day Course N.E. Lat Lon 191

Saturday Dec 17<sup>th</sup>

Commences with fine breezes from E.S.E. all hands  
employed in ships duty middle parts strong  
breezes latter parts same so ends this day  
nothing in sight Course N.E. Lat Lon 192

Sunday Dec 18<sup>th</sup>

Commences with fine breezes from E.S.E. all  
hands employed in tarring down anything in  
sight middle parts strong breezes from E.S.E. at  
7 the watch below so ends this day fine weather  
Course N.E. by N Lat 21° 59' Lon 193

Monday December 19<sup>th</sup>

Commences with fine weather nothing in sight  
the watch below middle parts fine sand porpoises  
the watch employed in duty so ends this day  
Course N.E. by N Lat 19° 52' Lon 194

Tuesday Dec 20<sup>th</sup>

Commences with fine weather the watch employed  
in ships duty at dusk took in top gallant sails  
steering for the land middle parts fine & pleasant  
latter parts employed in fitting boats so ends this  
day good weather Course N.E. by N Lat by 8° 195-

Wednesday Dec 21<sup>st</sup>

Commences with fine weather the watch employed  
in fitting boats at sunset took in top gallant sails  
middle parts fine at 7 PM. went mainsail to  
repair so ends this day 196

Thursday Dec 22<sup>nd</sup>

Commences with fine weather raised sperm whales  
blackfish & killers, lowered 3 boats fastened to the  
starboard boat & killed took him alongside at 8 PM  
& set the watch, middle parts fine, at day light  
commenced cutting, saw more whales so ends this  
day fine Lat Lon 197

Friday Dec 23<sup>rd</sup>

Commences with fine weather, hose in the head  
commenced boiling middle parts fine latter parts  
same so ends this day boiling Lat 198

Saturday Dec 24<sup>th</sup>

Commences with pleasant weather boiling middle  
parts fine, at 11 AM finished boiling cleared up  
&c at day light washed off the watch below  
coopered the head so ends this day fine Lat 199

Sunday Dec 25<sup>th</sup>

Commences with pleasant weather the watch  
employed in cooping & filling up, middle parts  
fine & clear, at 7 PM the watch below saw black  
fish, hump, right whale built &c so ends this  
day Lat Lon 200

Monday Dec 26<sup>th</sup>

Commences with fine weather at 3 PM, made  
the land the weather coast of Peru, at sunset wore  
ship & took in sail middle parts fine & clear  
at daylight called all hands & commenced stowing  
down, wore ship forth the land so ends this day 201
