Monday May 14th

Commences with fine weather nothing in sight at sunset
tacked to the South west middle parts fine at day light
made sail the watch employed coopersing Latter parts
fine so ends this day Lat by obs Lon

Tuesday May 15th

Commences with fine weather nothing in sight the
watch employed at 4 P M raised a sulphur bottom
got tackles aloft for a stow down at sunset took in sail
heading to S. S. W middle parts fine & clear at day light
Commenced stowing down in the after hold on the larboard
side, latter parts fine nothing in sight so ends this
day Lat by Obs Lon

Wednesday May 16th

Commences with fine weather all hands employed
in stowing down at 8 P M saw a sail on the
weather quarter at 4 finished stowing down &
cleared up decks at dusk took in top gallant
sails 1st & courses set the watch middle parts fine
at day light made sail, unbent & mended main top gallant
sail fine weather but no whales bent top gallant sail
unbent the spanker mended and bent him, so ends
this day Lat by obs Lon

Thursday May 18th

Commences with fine weather nothing in sight
unbent the main top sail mended and bent him
~~unbent~~ the main top sail at dusk double reefed
the top sails luffed to the wind to N
