

5th went into the Isl of Mayo and got
 About 200 bushels of salt and 20 hogs
 a few Banannoes and Couconuts and then
 put to sea and on the 31 got 2 Sperm whale
 and on the 21 of Sept got the 1st Right
 whale from this time until the 13 of January
 1822 we got 2100 Barrels of oil we then
 put away for New Bedford where we
 Arrived on the 24 of March with our
 Crew all well excepting George Wernsley
 who had a fever sore on his leg that
 laid him up the most of the voyage
 where the George and Martha turned
 out 2000 Barrels of Right whale oil and
 110 Barrels of Sperm oil. The whole
 Cargo valued at \$20,038.50 Cents
