more raged for 2 or 3 Days on the 14
Lowered and got 4 whale and the 19
got an other and the 20 got one more
the 22 finished trying out the 23 and
24 a Gale of wind the 25 a squall
struck us and split our main top sail
and tore our fore sail all to rags
August the 1st the weather more
Moderate Lowered and got a large

whale the next Day so raged that we
lost the head in cutting in the 6th
More Moderate Lowered and got 2
whales and the next Day got 1 whale
the 10 and 18 got one each Day the 12
got 1 and much one the 15 got 1
whale the 18 got a whale on the 25
got another one the 30 stowed Down
and the 31 at 20 Clock in the morning
we lost our Main top mast Mizzen
trayel mast and fore top Gallant
yards all over the side at one the
Bow Boat was washed of the Crew
the 2 and 3 was spent in getting the
Spare top mast and riggin fitted on
the 4 Lowered the Boats and got 3
whales on the 12 Lowered and got 1 whale
on the 15 Lowered and got to 170th whale
on the 24 got a small whale nothing
worth remarking until the 31 when
we spoke the Ships Ocean and Mantic
Both of Nantucket By them we were
Informed of of the Damage Done to
Several ships by the late Gale
Particular the ~~Mer~~ and Eagle
