making out the chain hatch.
way we found several lost had

weather all hands employed in storing
down. the last 4 whales stored
down 98 barrels besides filling up
several casks that had partly leaked
out at 3 P.M. they took a lunar
observation and found that they were

These 24 hours Light trades and
clear pleasant weather at 5 A.M.
set the top gallant sails and royals
and at 11 A.M. wet the hold the
rest of the time the watch unemployed
at 3 P.M. they took a lunar
observation Long 114-03 west.

These 24 hours Light winds and
pleasant weather all hands
employed in setting up the
Fore and Main rigging Sat
by observation 24 miles North

These 24 Strong trades and pleasant

remarking - Sat 1-24 South
