June the 15th 1822 Spoke the Brigg & Sons of Liverpool Bound to Rio Janeiro twenty days out
 August the 14th 1822 Spoke the Ship Falcon of Nantucket Capt Chace from the South Pacific Ocean Bound home
 Oct the 1st 1822 Spoke the Ship Pinasse of New Bedford. Clark twenty two months out 11.00 Barrels of Sperm oil
 Oct the 1st 1822 Spoke the Ship Linda of Nantucket Capt Goram twenty two months out 10.00 Barrels of Sperm oil
 Oct the 1st 1822 Spoke the Ship Improvement of Nantucket Capt Coffin twenty eight months out 800 Barrels of Sperm and 400 of Whale oil
 Oct the 9th 1822 Came to Anchor in the Port of Callo where we Spoke the Ship Swift of New Bedford Capt Pinkham twelve months out 350 Barrels of Sperm oil
 Oct the 14th 1822 Spoke the Ship Wm Proctor of New Bedford Capt Toby six months out one small whale
