

September Tuesday the 7th 1852

This day commences with light squalls of wind and rain several sails in sight at 7 P.M. towed away the starboard boat and the captain went ashore at a small village on the Isl Flores village ~~light~~ Pijohn at 11 P.M. a boat come off to the ship with fruit to sell and staid about an hour and we got eggs apples grapes figs musmelons for tobacco. And clois the day end with a dead calm with the wind S. all the small crafts Heiting to the northerly Lat Long.

Wednesday the 8th 1852

This day commences with a light wind from N. particular direction at 4 P.M. 2 boats come of with potatoes onions and food. them On board the ship stood of shore 2 men Did not come of Richard Quinn and Williams Williams ran away and we ship Potegenis in this place at 7 P.M. spoke the schooner of New Bedford Capt Gifford 15 kts boat Horn a shore after water but letters on board to be sent home and went on board of our ship and squared the yards for the Porpus banks Lat Long

September Thursday the 9th 1852

This day commences with a light breeze from the westward steering to the S.E. & several sails in sight the day ends with a good breeze

Lat Long 31° 20' N 130° 20' W

Friday the 10th 1852 This day commences with a strong wind from the S.E. & W steering S.E. & at 1 P.M. saw the Isl of Pico St George and Graveloes at 6 P.M. the night sail at 9 P.M. took in the main gaffentail 7th night sparkling at 3 P.M. took 2 reefs in the fore and main topsail The day ends with a strong breeze from S.E. steering S.E. several sails in sight Lat 35° 30' N Long 127° 40' W

Saturday the 11th 1852 This day commences

With a light breeze from the N steering fore the wind toward away the waist boat to 1 for grapephorus Come on board at 3 P.M. the latter part of the day men employed setting up the fil stais

Sunday the 12th 1852 This day commences with a light breeze from the N steering fore the wind toward away the waist boat to 1 for grapephorus Come on board at 3 P.M. the latter part of the day men employed setting up the fil stais Lat 36° 59' N Long 125° 27' W
