the day ends with a light breeze

WEDNESDAY # 27
to day a light breeze from the N steering
S W by W saw whitewater this day ends
with a light wind
Lat 16° 37' S Long 41'

Thursday # 28 1852 This day commences
with a good breeze from the W E steering S W by W
saw Blackfish Porpoises and Frampises
took in sail at 6 PM spoke the Barque
Hydrapa had Bibles 75 pound around the Horn
3 month out we went one hard the day
ends well Lat 16° 59' S Long 48° 10' W
lost one boat
star over
board by the sea
around his day

Friday # 29 the day commences
with a good wind saw several merchant
saw jumpers men employed in fixing the
harbord boat upon the house steering to
the Southward by the wind the day ends good
Lat 16° 58' S Long 36° 51'

SATURDAY # 30 commences
with a good breeze steering W by W saw
jumpers and one sail men employed in
sitting over potatoes and onions this day
ends good Lat 16° 14' S Long 37° 13' W

Sunday # 31 commences with a
strong breeze from the Eastward steering by the
wind saw one breeches saw three sail
to day has several squalls of rain the latter part
of the day steering S E Lat 16° S Long 41'
