with a good wind from the N.E.  
spoke the ship Adder <sup>from Messport</sup> Capt

once we hoared away the starboard boat  
and went on board

Sunday # 14 the day commences with

a good breeze we saw breeches sunset  
out to be sperm whales we hoared 3 boats at  
8 past 3 P.M. and the Captain got fast  
to a small whale and killed him  
and cut this line and went and got fast  
to another the starboard boat got close on  
to but saw them a went down chased them  
till sunset and went and took one of the  
Captains whale and took them and got  
about 9 o'clock P.M. holed the along  
side and put the flock chains on them at  
5 P.M. got the cutting gear and went  
to cutting in got him cut <sup>fast</sup> 16 feet 10 of the
