at 2 PM commences with a light breeze  
 broke for beans sugar meal rice  
 at 4 PM 12 raised spurs whales  
 and at 1 PM hoared away the boats  
 we got within quarter of a mile of one  
 we chased them 23 hours they  
 was going to the windward so  
 fast that we could not get  
 up to them saw Grampuses and  
 to sail got one turtle this day  
 verably ends with a calm breeze  
 Long



Course Wind Monday the 27 commences with  
 no verabally calm breeze saw two sails saw  
 no Porpoises and Grampuses  
 caught two alchors  
 the day ends with a light breeze  
 Long

Friday the 28 commences  
 with a light breeze spoke the  
 Reglant of New Bedford Capt  
 Pease Boats 6 months 200  
 got one turtle this day  
 ends with a light breeze  
 Long

Wednesday the 29 with a light  
 breeze saw Grampuses and Porpoises  
 and one turtle several sails  
 men employed in scraping the  
 rust of the fore and main chains  
 this day ends with a light breeze  
 Long had a thunder  
 squall of wind  
 and rain took  
 in all sail but  
 storm sails
