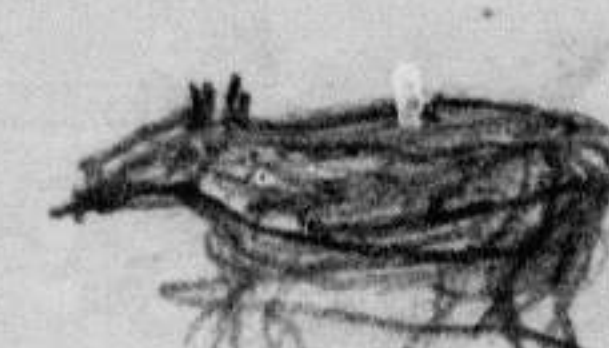


Thursday December 30 commences with breeze saw Grampases and Porpoises scraped the mast of the winlass and pointed it this day ends with a good breeze caught one al Long

Thursday the 6 commences with a strong breeze took in the jib and speaker at 11 AM saw pumpers this day ends with a strong breeze Long
