 January Monday # 24
 W SSW commences with a light breeze
 at 4 Past 7 No saw spurns white
 of the leamm beam at 8 PM
 N W NE boared away 3 boats and the last
 boat struck one and killed
 him got him along side at 10
 the others boats chasing the whale
 N W NE out sight of the ship but
 could see the day ends with light breeze
 Light 6 blb Long



Tuesday # 25

E by S NE Raised S W Macomber commences
 with a good breeze men employed
 N W WSW in cutting in the whale and trying
 out the blubber saw Grampases the
 N W WSW day ends with a heavy wind
 Light Long

NE ENE
 commences with heavy squalls of wind
 S ESE and rain men employed in boiling out
 the blubber out the blubber at 2 PM
 E S had a heavy squall we took in all sail
 but close reefed main, topsail and to
 all night Light Long

Course Wind January Thursday 27 commences
 E S E with a strong breeze men employed
 in breaking out for water ~~was~~
 and stowed down the oil 1 1/2 blb
 E by S S E saw one sail Light Long

SE SSW Friday # 28 with a strong breeze
 saw Grampases Porpoises and one sail
 men employed in skipt duty the
 day ends with light breeze
 Light Long

S WSW Saturday # 29 the day commences
 with a light breeze saw 2 sail men
 employed in making scrub broom
 S WSW mate employed in making a wheel
 S W WSW grating the day ends with slight breeze
 Light Long

Sunday 30
