men employed butting the Masts
N^o S^o N^o got rigging over the mast head
this day end with a light breeze

ES^o NE one sail men employed in ships
SSW NE duty the day ends with a good breeze

with a good breeze saw 3 sail about
the foregalentail caught 5 Albacores

Wednesday the 9th this day commences with

about 3 P^m had a heavy squall
of wind and some rain so that
N^o E ES^o we had to take in light sail to reef
in the topsails the day ends with a strong breeze

saw 2 sail the wind increased

out of the topsail and hoisted the
main galentail the day end

strong breeze saw one sail men employed
