Saturday the 19th nothing particular doing. Sunday 20th the fore part of the day got things in readiness for to sail the next morning the steward left all suspicion that that he sum on shore on a chest led put in Perry Brighton in steered and ship becher sat our sponyard on shore got under way about 7 P.M. the Cacedo and the Tropic Bird sailed about and hour before leaving the Sacramento alone
