and carried our letters for St. Thomas,

Tuesday the 22nd the sunrise saw
Porto Rico stood in for Dead Chest
where we came to anchor at 10 AM
where we found the *Neapolis* and the
schooner *Alamania* of sopean the
former of *Neapolis* had killed a large
hump back but lost him

Wednesday the 23rd went on shore
to get some *Linconita* soon went a
boating got 12 Capt went a fishing
and fowling got to fish and several
fowls ~~with~~ went a turkeling got some
old Brown from P. Rico came side
and brought some Oranges

Thursday the 24th 1853
men employed in coaking and fishing
and gaining at 6 AM got under
way and stood to sea in company
of the *Neapolis* and the schooner
Alamania saw several sail

NW NE Friday the 25th commenced with a
light breeze saw several sail the
latter part of the day the breeze
increases Latt Long

NW NE Saturday the 26th
commenced with a good breeze
saw breeches painted the starboard
Latt Long

NW NE Sunday the 27th with a good
breeze saw nothing of any account
broke out for *Water*
Latt Long

breeze men employed in painting
the waist boat
