with a strong breeze, saw the Grayhound

April the 1st Friday 1853
a strong breeze through the day
sat up the fore and main rigging
Saturday the 2nd commenced
with a strong breeze saw porpoises
and on sail Latt Long

Sunday the 3rd a strong breeze
threw the day saw porpoises and took
out for water and beef
Latt Long

April the 4th Monday 1853

commenced with a gale saw one whale
home and bound reefed the topsail
and furled the main-sail

Tuesday the 5th a strong breeze
saw one finback

Wednesday the 6th a strong breeze
the day saw one whale and
a finback

Thursday strong breeze threw
the day saw several sail and
Porpoises finback and squid

Latt Long

Friday the 8th 1853

commenced with a light breeze
at 4 P.M. saw a school of
Whales for which we hoisted
stuck one slightly the son
the iron duff and we son gave
up the chase for the night at
4 P.M. saw them again and lost
but could not get on so we let them go
Lat 31° 02' N Long 49° 3' W
