Monday the 18th

commences with a light breeze saw
Porpoises and Grampuses the day ends
with a light breeze
Lat Long

Tuesday the 19th
commences with a strong breeze
saw Grampuses so ends this day

Wednesday the 20th
commences with a light breeze
saw Porpoises none to riding
Lat Long

Thursday 21st
commences with light breeze struck
me Porpoises but lost them
Lat Long

Friday 22nd
commences with a light breeze at sun
set shortened sail could not see land at
day but saw land shadow for it
sent a boat on shore at 10 am
Lat Long

April 1853
Saturday 23rd
With a light breeze laying off and on
at day the boat came on board
it stop bringing some eggs and
some beef the old man stand on
shore the San Francisco set at anchor
then Capt Phillips of New Bedford
with 50 sperm 3 months out
the boat went ashore at 9 PM
Lat Long

Sunday the 24th
commences with a light breeze
laying off and on at day
the San Francisco B. Porpoises stood down
threw the large saw Porpoises and
Grampuses and struck
Lat Long

Monday the 25th
very light breeze trying to get down
to Japan saw Porpoises
Lat Long
