of Westport saw four boats

Monday the 9th spoke the President laying
down in the cow yard broke out
bread and water
Lat Long

Tuesday the 10th still laying down in
the cow yard it gave a gail
of wind spoke the Greyhound
President and Governor Carver
of Westport 18 months out
330 sperm 20 Black fish the
day ends with strong breeze
sailing a race with the
Greyhound so ends this day
Lat Long

Wednesday the 11th we beat the Greyhound
the last 24 ours passed the
ship Garland but did not speak
her saw the President and Governor
Carver the latter part of
the day ends with a strong
breeze with some rain
Lat Long
