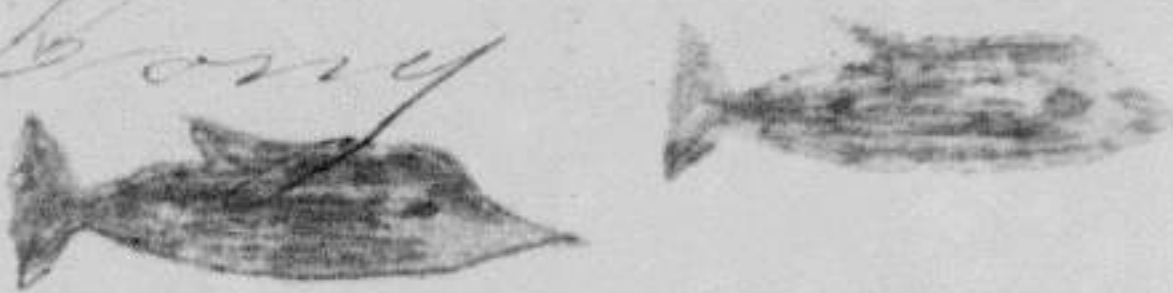


May 1853

Sunday the 29th confine with a light breeze
poke the Governor Carver she had
got 2 lb of Black fish we last
saw her she reported the President
a Baking she poke the aballs
nothing we end this day
Lat Long

Monday the 30th spoke the President
she had taken 40 lbs since we
last saw her sent down the
Hersail and mended it
Caught 2 Porpoise so ends
Lat Long



Tuesday the 31st commences with
a light breeze which increased
to a gale the latter part of the
day I spoke the Governor Carver
of Westport she had seen
nothing since we last saw
her the day ends with
a good breeze
Lat Long

June 1853

Wednesday the 1st strong gale there the
day broke out for molasses
Lat Long

Thursday the 2nd strong breeze ran down
under the lee of the cow
yard spoke the Governor Carver of
Westport and sold 3 lb of
molasses also spoke the President
Lat Long

Friday the 3rd commences with strong
breeze pushed up a part of the
yard being sick or got the day
ends with light breeze and rain

Saturday the 4th strong breeze through
the day spoke the Greyhound
had seen nothing since we had seen
her last
Sunday 5th Fresh breeze through the day
spoke the Governor Carver and
Greyhound saw Porpoises and
Porpoises
