very light wind with some rain
saw the Maaty several merchant
vessels broke out for flour feed
Lat 36, 40 Long 45, 55

Thursday the 4th
Light winds saw several jammers
Lat 37, 21 Long 42, 13

Friday 5
light breeze through the day saw
several sails at 5 P.M. spoke the
Harcloff of Bedford 89 days out
got some paper and letters
Lat 36, 22 Long 41, 12

Saturday the 6 of August 1853
light breeze through the day broke
out for water and molasses
and ringer saw the Harcella

Sunday the 7
Lat 36, 02 Long 41, 23
light winds saw porpoises ^{granphuses}
killed our pig

Monday the 8
Lat 35, 58 Long 41, 25
muse with light breeze frequent
squalls of wind and rain saw one
sail the latter part of the day strong
breeze Lat 36, 50 Long 41, 22

Tuesday the 9th
with strong breeze some wind
and rain men employed in
over hauling blocks the latter
part of the day quite moderate
to saw 3rd sail Lat 37, 27 Long 41, 12

Wednesday the 10th
strong breeze through the day saw
jammers and several sail
Lat 37, 24 Long 41, 50
