the 13

light wind through the day saw one
sail grampuses Porpoise
broke out for water Lat 34, 37 Long 41, 43

Sunday the 14

commenced very light wind men
employed in ship duty saw grampuses
Porpoise the day ends with a good breeze
Lat 35, 03 Long 41, 38

Monday the 15th

strong breeze through the day
broke out for water saw 2 sail
Lat 35, 53 Long 41, 29

Tuesday the 16

strong breeze with some rain and
a very heavy sea Lat 36, 46 Long 42, 06

Wednesday the 17 of August 1853

commenced with a strong breeze and
some rain saw several ~~schools~~ and
one school of blackfish the latter
part of the day moderate

Lat 36, 17 Long 42, 09

Thursday the 18

commenced with fine weather and
light wind saw blackfish the
latter part of the day good breeze
Lat 36, 17 Long 42, 09

Friday the 19 strong breeze with some
rain broke out for flour saw
grampuses Porpoises blackfish &c

Lat 35, 05 Long 41, 58

Saturday the 20

fine weather with a good breeze
saw jumpers Porpoises broke out
for bread Lat 34 44 Long 40, 57

Sunday the 21st

light wind and fine weather saw
Porpoises and jumpers
Lat 35, 56 Long 40 23
