commenced with strong gale
with some rain saw jumpers
grampuses Porpoises and
several sail the day ends with
strong gale Lat 38 08 Long 33 33

Monday the 29

strong breeze with saw nothing
Lat 37 35 Long 35 38

Tuesday the 30

strong breeze saw nothing in
distance
