

Thursday September the 1st 1853

Lying to in the Passage way between
Hayti and Pico sent a boat on shore
For recruits saw the Bark Bothchilds
of Boston Capt small the Bark Franklin
of New Bedford capt lee and the
Georg of Newport Jerney at anchor
in the harbor saw the Sally Ann of
New Bedford Hawthorn Metacome
of New Bedford Woodbridge
the Kalthleen of New Bedford
Capt Allen the Mexico of Newport
Collins the sea flower of New Bedford
Cadworth the Anniston of ~~New Bedford~~
of Walpole Pacey
The Sloop of New Bedford week
Pine of Loyal Luvra laying off
and on with a boat on shore for recruits
a bum boat came along side with
some fruit and basket to sell but
they asked so high that we did
not trade much with them the
day ended with bright breeze

Friday September the 2nd 1853

Course Winds Put still on shore a barge
came along side about 2 o'clock
bringing 11 bbls of Beef and 11 bbls
5 cask of Bread 3000 of onions
51 bush of potatoes 100 Turneps
104 beets 1 bushel of Peaches and
one rusta we then stood for
Teacira the day ends with a good
breeze stowed down our Provision

Saturday the 3rd Light wind attended
with some rain saw Porpoise
SSE S W Grampuses and Finbacks
the day ends with strong breeze
standing along shore of Teacira
for St Michaels

Sunday the 4th strong breeze with some
SSE S W rain at 10 P M saw Michaels
and Grampuses and Porpoise

Monday the 5th
by the S W ~~Light~~ wind through the day
spoke the ship Metacome of
N B capt Woodbridge 25 day
out clean had a game and
got some Papers
