

Wednesday September the 14th 1853

Coarse Wind strong breeze through the day
SE NE saw nothing still keeping to
the southward at 7 AM with
a strong breeze and reef 2 sails
Lat 22° 26' N Long 19° 53' W

Thursday the 15 strong breeze part of the
day saw 2 sails Porpoises
cowfish broke out for Pelour
Bungear the day ends well
Lat 20° 12' Long 18° 40'

Friday the 16
commences with pleasant wind
but get to be rather inconvenient
before the close the day saw
the Is of Palma one of the Canaries
Lat Long

Saturday the 17
strong breeze but decent the
latter part of the day layed
to under Hero till morning
kept off for the Cape Verde
Lat 27° 12' Long 17° 25'

Sunday September the 18th 1853

Coarse Wind strong breeze through the day
SE NE saw several sails and Hatt
Lat Long

Monday the 19
strong breeze with a light
SE NE sprinkling of rain saw Porpoises
cowfish and Hatt the latter
part of the day strong breeze
Lat 23° 26' N Long 16° 55' W

Tuesday the 20
strong breeze through
the day saw Porpoises
and cowfish caught
a Hatt
Lat 21° 18' N Long 18° 27'

Wednesday the 21 strong breeze with squalls
SE NE of rain saw Porpoises and
cowfish broke out for Hatt the
latter part fine Lat 19° 12' N Long 17° 09'

Thursday the 22
NE moderate breeze saw fufacks and
Porpoises set up the fore topmast and
gallant backstay
Lat 18° 42' N Long 17° 00'
