strong breeze through the

Tuesday the 8

E strong breeze saw one sail
no Long

Wednesday the 9

strong breeze with some rain
SSW SE saw nothing
Lat 10° 48' Long 33° 05'

Thursday 10th

strong breeze through the
day with some rain break
out for Beef Pork Wood and
E Matter saw Porpoises strong
O but lost them all
Lat 9° 31' Long 31° 41'

Friday November the 11th 1853

Cause Winds strong breeze with some rain
N E saw nothing
Lat 11° Long 33°

Saturday the 12

N ESE Rain and wind saw nothing
except Porpoises
Lat Long

Sunday the 13

some rain and a very little
wind saw 3 sails ship jacks
shores Cowfish and Grampuses
N E towed a boat for a Turtle
a Hawkbill specie
but with out success
Lat 10° 30' N Long 33° 35'

Monday the 14

fine weather with very light
winds saw Grampuses Porpoises
Lat 10° 49' N Long

Tuesday the 15

fine weather saw nothing worthy
of note men employed
in repairing the fore topsail
Lat 11° 28' N Long 31° 35'
