

Arrived December the 16th 1853
 Coarse Wind commences with light breeze
 Ran close in to the land
 of Saminae and lay all night
 it being nearly calm at 7 AM
 Captain went on shore in the
 Harbor boat and we came in
 about 11 PM the Captain came
 off bringing about 300 or more
 Oranges and some Potatoes
 so ends the day

Saturday the 17 sent a raft of cask on
 shore for better got of about
 150 bbls of water 2 cords of
 wood

Sunday the 18 fine weather a boat came
 along side about 7 PM bringing
 500 of yams 7 bbls of Potatoes
 600 Oranges and some coconuts
 and Benjamins for which we
 gave 2 bbls of pork 100 lbs of
 Bread at 9 AM laid anchor
 and went to sea had a fine
 breeze from the E steering
 E by N

Monday December 19th 1853
 Coarse Wind commences with a good breeze
 N.W. N.E. and fine weather saw the
 Isl Montserrat Nevis
 St Kitts St Eustacia
 and Saba the day ends a fine
 day
 Lat 17° 04' N Long 61° 00' E

Tuesday the 20 Fine weather and light
 winds through the day at
 N.W. E.N.E. sunrise saw the Islands of
 St Johns Santa Cruz Tortola
 and St Thomenases at 10 AM
 came to anchor in the harbor
 of St Thomenases

Wednesday 21 set the Starboard watch
 on shore harbor watch
 scraping and painting the
 Chains

Thursday the 22
 fine weather harbor watch
 on shore men employed
 in pumping Chains
