Monday the 2nd strong breeze with a
clear day at 4 P M came to
Anchor in the bay of the Island
of Casa de los Muertos men
employed in ship rigging out
the jib boom that bends this day

Tuesday 3 men still employed in
rigging out jib boom the
latter part of the night some
fish

Wednesday the 4th men employed in gunning
and fishing and some sleeping
Capt Brown from Porto Rico
came along side from which
we purchased some fish
and Oranges

Thursday the 5th of January 1854
Capt Brown came along side
again and we purchased some more
Oranges and sold him 2 bbls of
Blackfish oil at \$2.00 per bbl at
10 A M the Barkley of Westport
Capt Tripp dropped anchor
near us & gave out 400 sperm
got some letters and saw some
old acquaintances

Friday the 6th Doing nothing

Saturday 7th "Ditto"

Sunday the 8th At sunrise took
our Anchor on board to the
Westward for Pooka leaving
the barkley at Anchor

Monday the 9th
Luffed to the wind off Pooka for
for a crase saw several sail

Tuesday the 10th Strong breeze saw
several sails saw the
Barkley
