

Saturday January the 21st 1854
Strong Breeze Stearing for sea
Saw Beta and Alvarado

Sunday 22nd

Strong breeze through the day at
at 11 came to anchor in
Samp Bay with the Sparrow
of Perennation Rock 12. 12. 12.

Monday the 23rd

Strong gales through the day
sat up the head stays so ends
this day

Tuesday the 24th the Breeze gale and
clear weather all hand employed
in setting up the fore rigging

Wednesday the 25th

Fine weather with a strong wind
set up the main rigging at 7
P M under way and stood
out from land

Thursday January 26th 1854

Strong gale at 2 P M came to
anchor in Cook Cove Got a
mess of conchs the day end with
a gale of wind

Friday the 27th commences with a gale
at 6 P M the Brig Genl of
Bevelly came to anchor near us

Saturday the 28th Fresh gale and clear
at 10 A M got underway and
beat out of Cook Cove in company
with the Sparrow the day with
light breeze

Sunday the 29th commences with light

breeze at 9 A M lowered for
Blackfish but with out success
at 11 A M spoke the Barkley
boiling the day end with fresh
Monday 30 strong breeze gale
through the day saw nothing
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
