I commenced with a strong breeze
and pleasant weather
at 5 PM got under
sail and for Chalk
Cliffs so ends the day

Saturday 12 Light breeze through
the day 4 sail in store
men employed in setting
up the Morscaen rigging

Sunday the 13th
Fine weather through the
day saw Blackfish
Chalk Cliffs 10 miles distant

Tuesday February the 14th 1854
Coarse wind light breeze through the day
fine weather men employed in
tarring down 4 Whalers in
sight

Wednesday the 15th Light breeze and fine
weather men employed in ship duty
Chalk Cliffs bearing N 41°

Thursday the 16th Fine weather through the
day men employed in tarring rigging

Friday the 17th Commences with light breeze
at 2 PM came to anchor in Long
Cove where we found the brig Andie
of Sandwich Capt Chadwick
10 months out 300 spars Brig
Gen. came to anchor near us
all hand employed in tarring
down the day ends with a strong
SE breeze
