

Saturday February the 18th 1854
Course Wind Strong breeze through the day
men employed in painting at 3 PM
Bark Ben Franklin of Beothic
the schooner Antactic and the
Harit Deal of Provincetown came
to anchor making 7 in all to
anchor in Conk Cove

Sunday the 19th
Strong breeze through the day all
hands to anchor finished painting
the larboard side another schooner
came to Anchor merchantman

Monday the 20 Moderate breeze through
the day 2 Briggs and 2 schooner
sailed all hand employed in painting

Tuesday the 21 Fine weather through the day
all hand employed in painting the ship

Wednesday 22 Moderate gale through the
day all hands employed in painting
finished painting the spars

Thursday February the 23rd 1854
Course Wind Light breeze at and fine weather
finished painting and stowed
off the hatchway so ends this day

Friday the 24 Light breeze and fine weather
all hands employed in mending
and bending sails

Saturday the 25 strong breeze through the day
the whaling fleet came ^{into} the harbor
9 of them with one merchantman
the Bark at ready for sea rattling
down and lugging down
Strong breeze so ends the day

Sunday the 26 strong breeze all ready
for sea waiting for the wind
to moderate 8 sails at anchor
waiting for moderate weather

Monday the 27
Fresh gales through the day
at 5 PM the W.D. Chase came
to anchor making 9 sails in all
to anchor in Conk Cove
