

Tuesday February 28th 1854

Course Wind Commences with a strong breeze
at 7 AM got under way and
stood out Couch Cove for the
last time for this voyage saw
Humpbacks so ends the month

Wednesday March 1st 1854

W E Light winds the fore part of
the day saw several sails at
5 PM kept off before the wind
& a strong breeze so ends this

Thursday the 2nd Commences with strong

W N E breeze the latter part of the day
light breeze Cape Tiboron
bearing N N E 250 miles dist

Friday the 3rd Light breeze through the day

W N E saw several sails so ends
the day

Saturday the 4th Light wind through

N E the day saw nothing

Sunday March 5th 1854

Course Wind Light breeze through the day
saw the Island of Gomara
bearing E S E dist 25 miles

Monday the 6th Commences with a light

N E breeze saw several sails and
N E Porpoises and Grampse and
Cape saint Michel about 25

Tuesday 7th Strong breeze through
the day at 4 PM kept off
before the wind and sent a new
top sail and foresail and Gaff
board home

Wednesday the 8th Commences with

W N E strong breeze saw several Turtle
W N E found 2 Barks stores and
lost about 5 cwt of oil firewater
stowing down the latter part
of the day the day ends
with a moderate breeze
at 1 PM 160 Long Is. 1854
