

Remarks on board the *Porpoise*
 during the first
 voyage

On the day with a light breeze
 we came to anchor at sunset
 in 3 or 4 fathoms from the shore
 and a small boat the returned upon
 the 18th of August they shot
 and saw three seals

Monday the 20th

The ship with a strong wind
 proceeded north

Tuesday the 21st

Proceeding the day
 were employed in making
 the ship out side and pumping
 the down part down to the
 water within the deck
 and proceeded

Barque Charles Capt. Duff commander
 July 18th 1855

Wednesday the 24th

Proceeding north
 men ashore etc and
 the day

Thursday the 25th
 to day with a
 strong breeze

Proceeding north the
 having made left side
 to note the vessel
 the men employed in
 pumping the ship out side

Friday the 26th

Proceeding north the
 commenced with pleasant
 weather the first came of
 and here the first did not
 get into calm the
 day ends pleasant
