January 9 and clear weather Middle and
Satter part continues light breezes
steering to the North
Sailed by Obs 14-50

January 10 and clear weather at 3 PM
saw a shoal of whales leaved
the boats and got one at 5
PM finished cutting middles
and Satter part strong breezes
employed in boiling
Sailed by Obs 14-25

Sunday Commences with light breezes
January 11 and clear weather at 6 PM
finished boiling at 4 PM tacked
to the Westward Middle and
Satter part strong breezes and
foggy weather the land in sight
Sailed by Obs 14-27

Monday Commences with strong
January 12 breezes and clear weather
at 7 PM spoke the ship *Phoebe*
of Nantucket Middle and Satter
part strong breezes and clear
weather the land in sight
Sailed by Obs 14-00

Tuesday Commences with strong winds and
January 13 clear weather at 7 PM shortened sails
at 5 AM made all sail and started
NW saw a ship to the seaward
Satter part strong breezes and clear
weather
Sailed by Obs 13-2
