January 14 trades and clear weather
staring. All sail set at
7 PM shortened sails and
and latter part strong breezes
at 8 AM spoke the ship Edward General
of Gall river. Sailed by lbs 12.20

Thursday Commences with strong breezes
January 15 and clear weather staring to
the Eastward at 7 PM shortened
sail. Middle and latter part
moderate breezes and clear
weather staring to the Eastward

Friday Commences with strong breezes
January 16 and clear weather staring to
the Eastward at 4 PM saw
the land at 7 PM shortened sail
Middle and latter part
strong breezes at 8 AM started
W & W all sail set saw a Spanish
schooner empty in porting the ship

Saturday Commences with strong breezes
January 17 and clear weather at 7 PM
shortened sail. Middle and latter
part light breezes staring to the
North saw a sail to the windward
Sailed by lbs 09.32

Sunday Commences with light breezes
January 18 and clear weather staring
to the North at 6 PM shortened
sail. Middle and latter part
moderate breezes at 8 AM saw the
land and a brig staring to the
W & W

Sailed by lbs 8.12

Monday Commences with strong breezes
January 19 and clear weather all sail set
at 7 PM shortened sail
Middle and latter part light
breezes and clear weather staring
N & E

Sailed by lbs 09.4

Tuesday Commences with light breezes
January 20 and clear weather at 4 PM
saw the Lopez Islands at 7 PM
shortened sail staring to the North
Middle and latter part light breezes
staring to the North the land in sight

Sailed by lbs 5.53

Wednesday Commences with strong breezes
January 21 and clear weather all sail in
at 4 PM. bent both cables
at 7 PM shortened sail at 8 PM
lacked to the SW at 2 AM looked to
the Eastward at 4 AM made all
sail and started for Payta harbour
