April 2 and clear weather steering SSW
at 9 PM more ship to the NE and
shortened sail Middle and latter part
strong breezes and squally steering
N all sail set Sailed by Obs 5-07

Friday Commences with strong breezes
April 3 from SSE steering N at 4 PM
spoke the Barque Washington of
Hudson Middle and latter part strong
breezes with some squalls of rain
steering NW Sailed by Obs 4-23

Saturday Commences with strong breezes
April 4 spoke the ships Peace Courier
and Tobacco Plant of New Bedford
and Washington of Hudson Middle and
latter part light breezes and variable
with squalls of rain Sailed by Obs 4-17
