lower boats but could not strike

Friday Commences with moderate winds
December 17 in chase of whales at 1 PM toward the
boats and got one large one at 5 took
him along side at 11 AM finished toiling
No kls

December 18 at 5 PM tacked to the S.W. employed in
hoiling middle and latter part moderate
winds saw squalls of rain employed in
hoiling No kls

Sunday Commences with winds from S.E. employed
December 19 in hoiling at 8 finished Middle and latter
part strong wind from S.E. at ship in sight
to the forward Latit by Obs 29-00

Monday Commences with strong winds from S.E.
December 20 at 7 PM more ship to the S.E.
Middle and latter part strong gales
employed in stowing down
No kls Latit by Obs 28-43

Tuesday Commences with strong gales from
December 21 S.E. Sunday Island in sight bearing
S.W. Middle and latter part continues
strong winds and cloudy weather and raged
No kls

Wednesday Commences with strong winds from
December 22 S.E. and raged at 5 PM tacked to the
S.W. Middle and latter part continues winds
and high swell steering by to the S.E.
nothing in sight No kls

Thursday Commences with strong winds from
December 23 S.W. and a high swell steering by to
the S.E. a sail in sight to the forward
Middle and latter part strong gales from
W.S.W. main top sail and fore sail set
Latit by Obs 28-28
Long by Obs 177-30

Friday Commences with strong gales from W.S.W.
December 24 main top sail and fore sail set at 8 PM
more ship to the N.W. Middle and latter
part strong winds and high swell
Latitude by Obs 28-54
Long in 177-39
