ship to the West at 7 shortened Middle and
latter part strong winds from the SSE steering
by to the SW all sail set steering by to the
SW Sunday Island bearing NW Latit by Obs 28-54

Thursday Commenced with strong winds from SSE
January 7 all sail set at 7 PM shortened sail and wore
ship to the East Middle and latter part
moderate winds from SSE clear weather at
5 PM wore ship to the SW the Lutis Islands
bearing NW dist about 20 miles No Obs

Friday Commenced with moderate winds from
January 8 SSE at 5 PM tacked to the NE the Lutis
Islands bearing West Middle and latter part
strong winds some squalls of rain the

lower the boats and struck at 5 boats him
