March 16 from the NE some squalls of
rain Middle and latter part light
winds from NE to E some squalls
of rain lying at anchor at Pongatabo

Thursday Commences with moderate winds
March 17 from East at 2 PM got under
way from Pongatabo Middle part
heavy squalls of rain latter part
pleasant at noon saw Pylstarte Island
bearing West dist about 20 miles
Latit by Obs 22.12

Friday Commences with strong winds from
March 18 ESE steering by to the South at 5 PM
shortened sail Middle and latter part
strong winds with squalls of rain steering
by to the South Latit by Obs 23.27

Saturday Commences with strong winds from
March 19 the E steering by to South middle and
latter part strong gales with squalls
of rain steering by to the North
Latit by Obs 23.54

Sunday Commences with strong gales and
March 20 rigid steering by to the South
middle and latter part moderate winds
some squalls of rain Latit by Obs 23.07

Monday Commences with light winds from
March 21 East at 6 PM more ship to the S
saw Pylstarte Island bearing North
middle and latter part light winds
No Obs

Tuesday Commences with light winds from
March 22 ESE in chase of a large whale
at 1 PM lowered the boats could not strike
Middle and latter part moderate winds
and thick weather Pylstarte Island bearing
No Obs

Wednesday Commences with light breezes and thick
March 23 weather Middle and latter part strong winds
from NW squalls of rain nothing in
sight No Obs

Thursday Commences with strong winds from
March 24 NW squalls of rain at 5 PM more ship
to the NE Middle and latter part squally
latter part pleasant nothing in sight

Friday Commences with light breezes from
March 25 NW steering by to the NW saw Pylstarte
Island bearing NE Middle and latter part
light winds Pylstarte Island in sight
Latit by Obs 22.34

Saturday Commences with light winds and squalls
March 26 of rain steering in for Pylstarte Island
at 4 PM the boats came on board
middle and latter part light winds laying
off and on at Pylstarte Island

Sunday Commences with moderate winds and
March 27 clear weather steering by to the NE at 5
shortened sail Middle and latter part moderate
winds and clear weather at 10 AM saw
the Island Cook bearing NE dist about
40 miles Latit by Obs 22.02

Monday Commences with light winds and clear
March 28 weather at 4 PM saw whale lowered the
boats could not strike Middle latter part
light winds at noon the Island Cook
bore NNE dist about 40 miles
Latit by Obs 22.23
