new gill sheets made some hatch bars lash
down down the hatches &c so ends this day

Sun Jan 16 Lat 26 01 S Lon 40 39
First part of these twenty four hours
doubtly weather strong breeze from N E
steering S W by W took in topgallins
dubbed reef the topsails hoisted the boats
up on the upper chains &c last part squally
weather wind N E steering S W so ends this day

Mon Jan 17
First part squally weather wind from S W to
to west the watch employ in taking in
sail and working ship &c last part fine
weather bent new main top gallensail some
set rigging &c so ends this day

Tue Jan 18 Lat 30 02 S Lon 42 52 W
First part these twenty four hours fine
weather strong breeze from N S W steering
on the wind S by W the watch employ
on the rigging &c

Wed Jan 18 Lat 31 58 S Lon 45 9 W
First part these twenty four hours light wind
from W S W steering S W by W sent down
four top royal yard and mast set up front top
gallant rigging &c last part fine weather the watch
employ on the rigging so ends this day

First part these twenty four hours fine weather
light breeze from W steering S W the watch
employ on the rigging &c last part fine weather
the watch employ on the rigging &c so ends this day

strong winds from south west the watch employ
cleaning the carpenter tools picking over &c
last part fine light winds from W S W

&c last part fine weather wind from N E
