with fresh breeze from the north with
showers of rain steaming S W by W
exchange signals with an english barque
steaming N E last part fresh breeze from
North steaming S W by W

Tues Feb 15 Lat 56,14 S Lon 67,19 W
Thurs twenty four hours commence with
fresh breeze from W steaming N E and by
last part fresh breeze from N N E
steaming west

Wed Feb 16 Lat 58,04 S Lon 69,23 W
Thurs twenty four hours commence
with fresh breeze from N N E steaming W
last part moderate gale from W S W
have the ship to under close reef main
topsail

Thurs Feb 17 Lat 58,15 S Lon 70,59 W
Thurs twenty four hours commence with
fresh breeze from N E steaming W by W
saw two ships to the leeward steaming the
same last part fresh breeze from S to south
at 4 AM had the ship under
close reef fore and main topsail

Fri Feb 18 Lat 57,16 S Lon 74,04
Thurs twenty four hours commence
with fresh breeze from W by S steaming on
the wind to the westward saw a large ship to the
windward steaming the same last part fine weather
the wind from S W

Sat Feb 19 Lat 57,02 S Lon 74,10 W
Thurs twenty four hours commence with
the winds from S W fine weather for Cape
horn, last part the wind from S W heavy
fine for the season

Sun Feb 20 Lat 57,37 S Lon 75,00 W
Thurs twenty four hours commence with fine
weather the breeze from the north steaming W by W
last part fine weather the breeze from N E

Mon Feb 21 Lat 57,05 S Lon 76,30 W
Thurs twenty four hours commence with fine
weather the breeze from S E steaming W S W at two
AM set a foresail last part fresh breeze
from S W steaming N W

Tues Feb 22 Lat 58,30 S Lon 77,20
Thurs twenty four hours commence with
fresh breeze from W S W steaming N N W
last part the same part an English Brig
steaming the same

Wed Feb 23 Lat 52,35 S Lon 79,05 W
Thurs twenty four hours commence with
fresh breeze from N W standing on the wind
to the westward saw a large american ship
standing the same way last part strong
breeze from S W thick fog
