

Remarks off Cape Horn Jan 1860

And turned up the Boat's sail in sight of heavy
Cross sea running & heavy squalls so ends
88 days out

Saturday 28th

Begin with a moderate gale from the SSW
Steering NW by W under easy sail plenty of squalls
Middle part more moderate made sail steering
NW by N the wind from the N S W Lattas part
The same 89 days out

Sunday 29th

Begin with strong Breezes from the
Westward attended with rain steering NW
by N under easy sail Middle part the wind
from the N W S W to the Westward
4 P M double reefed the topsails & reefed the
main sail blowing fresh Lattas part close reefed
the fore & main topsail so ends
90 days out

Monday 30th

Begin with a moderate gale from the S W
W heading the Westward 7 A M have her top
under easy sail Lattas part more moderate
made sail heading to the Westward
91 days out

Tuesday 31st

Begin with Moderate Breezes from the
W N W heading to the S W Westward under easy
sail 5 A M caught a porpoise & latched to
the Westward Middle of Lattas part light
winds attended with rain & heavy swell from
the Westward heading on the wind to haul
the porpoise & haul bread & porpoise for supper
92 days out

Wednesday Jan 1st 1860

Begin with light winds from the N W S W
with rain heading on the wind to the Southward

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Middle of Lattas Strong Breezes from the
Westward with fine weather steering
N under all sail plenty of porpoise & fine
Back in sight Lat 48-40 Long 50-07 W
93 days out

Thursday 2nd

Begin with Strong Breezes from the W N W
with fine weather steering N under all
sail Middle of Lattas part the same steering
N P E 2 sail in sight Lat 46-18 Long 77-39 W
94 days out

Friday 3rd

Begin with moderate Breezes from the W
S W steering N by E with fine weather Middle
part the same Brought out for provisions & water
& A M put the waist Boat out at 3 P M
Raised the Is of Joffe passing N P E
About 15 miles dist 5 P M spoke the Beacon
Morning Light 5 month out 80 lbs heard
From the Ship Congaree 3 days previous
got her hull, work's store in and lost her
Galley off Cape Horn Lattas part light winds
steering N P W under easy sail
95 days out

Saturday 4th

Begin with light winds from the S W
steering N P W with fine weather under
easy sail Middle part calm Lattas part
light winds from the Westward heading to
the Southward under all sail 3 sail in sight
Lattas part the same all hands employed in
Ship's duty so ends this day of discontent
96 days out

Sunday 5th

Begin with Strong Breezes from the Westward
with rain heading to the Southward under easy
