

Remarks on the Coast of Chili Feb 1860

Sail Middle & latter part more moderate
10 AM tacked to the Northward and made
Sail fine weather dusk for dinner so ends
97 days out

Monday 6th

Begins with moderate Breezes from the
Westward Steering N by W under easy sail
Fine weather Land about 30 miles dist Middle
& latter part, the wind more from the Northward.
5 PM tacked to the Westward broke out
for small stores and filled water cask
The same old fare bread & meat
98 days out

Tuesday 7th

Begins with Strong Breeze from the Westward
Heading on the wind to the S by Westward Middle
Part A moderate gale with rain 6 AM have
then too under easy sail, latter part more moderate
1 PM were ship to the Northward & made sail
Fine weather Lat 40-39 S

99 days out

Wednesday 8th

Begins with strong Breezes from the N by W with
Rain squally heading on the wind to the N by E
5 AM tacked to the S by Westward blowing fresh
Middle part blowing A gale here her too under
Easy sail and turned up the Boat latter
Part more moderate the wind halting to the
S by W 3 PM were ship to the Westward took an
Obser found that the Land was about 18 miles
dist under our lee made all sail possible and
was off shore Steering N by W and Bread & meat
for Supper & meat & bread for breakfast
100 days out

Thursday 9th

Begins with a calm & heavy swell daylight took
A light Breeze from the N by W heading on the
Wind to the S by Westward fine weather 2 PM tacked
to the Northward got an obs and shaped our
Course for the Isl of Mocha about 90 miles dist
Latter part light winds from the N by W steering
N with all sail set
101 days out

Friday 10th

Begins with light winds from the S by W
With fine weather Steering N with all
Sail set At 8 AM raised the Isl of Mocha
Passing N by about 40 miles dist plenty of
Plenty Sulphur Bottoms & fine Beaches in
Sight Middle & latter part off the same At
7 PM the N by W end of the Isl bearing E by N
About 10 miles dist the wind light and baffling
102 days out Lat 38-24 S Long 74-18

Saturday Feb 11th

Begins with light baffling winds from the
Northward with pleasant weather Steering
In for the Land at daylight kept off before
the wind and ran close of the town 7 AM
The Boat went on shore came off at noon
With some potatoes & chickens & manakanda
By the name of Breed Middle part steering
Fresh with rain from the N by E kept her off
Before the wind around the Island and stuck
Out to sea under easy sail the latter part
more moderate

103 days out

Sunday 12th

Begins with light baffling winds from the
S by W steering N by W for the Land 10 AM took
