

Remarks on board on the Coast of Chili

Thursday 21st 1860

Begins with light winds from the Southward
With fine weather steering N. E. Middle
Past the same 2 P.M. spoke the Bayne
Anaconda of New Bedford 40 months out
1500 s.p.m. bound home Land about 20 miles off
113 days out

Friday Feb 22nd

Begins with light winds from the
Southward with fine weather steering
to the Northward under easy sail painted
The Larboard Boat and different parts of
The Ship Middle & Lattas past the same
cruising off Merens head Land about
20 miles dist Lat 23° S

114 days out

Saturday 23rd

Begins with light winds from the South
with fine weather standing in shore
On the wind painted the waist of Larboard
Boat At 2 P.M. Merens head bearing
E. S. E. 12 miles dist raised 3 Green Whales
Coming to the Windward quick run about
off the Ship & gallied them towards 2 boats
And chased until dark but without
success Middle & Lattas past fine weather
Working to the Southward after the Whales

115 days out Lat 23° 10' S

Sunday 24th

Begins with light winds from the S
With fine weather working to the South
Along the Land Middle & Lattas past the
Same saw A Bayne going to the Northward
10 A.M. saw A vessel gun off for it but
Did not see it again killed 2 Seals sundown
The Land about 20 miles off
115 days out

Feb 25th 1860

Begins with light winds from the Southward
With fine weather still cruising off the
Head Middle & Lattas past the same he
Capt for small stores Merens head bearing E
S. E. 116 days out

Sunday 26th

Begins with light winds from the South
with fine weather still cruising off the
Head Middle & Lattas past the same
Sundown tacked and stood off shore the
Land about 8 miles dist Lat 23° 20' S
117 days out

Monday 27th

Begins with moderate breezes from the
Southward with fine weather standing
Off shore under easy sail daylight more
Ship in shore 6 P.M. lowered for A. Thump
Began the Larboard Boat struck and killed
him and he sunk taking one line cut
from him and came on board more ship
Off shore the Land bearing E about 10 miles
dist 118 days out

Tuesday 28th

Begins with light winds from the South
ward with fine weather working to
The Northward along the Land & sail
In sight another light supper hard
Bread & meat so ends this day
119 days out

Wednesday 29th

Begins with light winds from the South
with fine weather working to the Northward
Middle & Lattas past the same one sail in
sight so ends
120 days out
