

Remarks on board the Ship Alfred
Friday 16th 1860

Begins with light winds from the S E
With good weather Steering W by S Middle
Latter part the same & P M took the man
that was in ions out of the main hatch
and put him in the sigger, the capt gave
him one blow and sent him to his Anty
137 days out so ends

Saturday 17th
Begins with Strong Breezes from the
E & S E Steering W under easy sail Middle
& Latter part the same so ends
138 days out

Sunday 18th
Begins with Strong Breezes from
the E & S E Steering W under easy sail
good weather sundown took in sail
And luffed to the wind on the Larboard
Tack 139 days out

Monday 19th
Begins with Strong Breezes from the
E & S E daylight kept her off W by N
Under easy sail Middle part rain
Squalls Latter part good weather
Sundown Luffed to on the Starboard
tacked 139th day Long 81-07 17-33 Lat

Tuesday 20th
Begins with Strong Trades from the
S E with rain squalls daylight kept
her off N W by W under easy sail
Middle & Latter part good weather
And strong trades variously employed
Things have taken a change of the
better but how long they will last
I do not know so ends this day
140th day

Gills on the coast of Peru & Nicholas Master
Wednesday 21st

Begins with Strong Trades from the
S E with fine weather Steering W N W
Under easy sail Middle & Latter part
The Sague variously employed in fitting
The Ship so ends this day
141st day out

Thursday 22nd
Begins with Strong Trades from the
S E good weather Steering N W by W
Under easy sail Middle & Latter part
the same variously employed about the Ship
142nd day

Friday 23rd
Begins with Strong Trades from the S E
with good weather Steering N W by W
Under easy sail & P M kept her N E
& P of a Patia Middle & Latter part the
same variously employed about the Ship
143 day out Long 55th W Lat 11-30 S

Saturday 24th
Begins with Strong Trades from the
S E with good weather Steering N E by E
Middle & Latter part the same caught
A lot of ship fish variously employed
144 day out

Sunday 25th
Begins with Strong Trades from the S E
with good weather Steering N E by E
Patia & Middle & Latter part the same one
sail in sight Steering to the N E towards
145 days out Monday 26

Begins with moderate trades from the S E
fine weather Steering on the wind to the Eastward
saw a school of Blackfish 4 P M kept her
off N E by E for Patia heard about 30 miles off
