

Remarks on board On the Line April
Saturday 7 1860

Begins with Moderate trades from the S.E.
With fine weather working to the Westward
Middle & Latter part the same variously
158 days out employed about the Ship

Sunday 8th
Begins with light trades fine weather
Working to the Westward on the wind
At 5 P.M. raised a school of Sperm Whales
Lowered 4 Boats the Larboard Boat struck
At sundown starb took him alongside day
By him all night
159 days out Lat 1-45 N Long 84-20 W

Monday 9th
Begins with moderate trades fine weather
Day light commenced cutting & at 10 finished
Made sail steering to the North & Eastward
After the Whales but did not see them 2
P.M. hauled on the wind to the westward
160 days out

Tuesday 10th
Begin the same fine weather working to
the Westward on the wind 2 P.M. started
The Mosks one sail in sight Merchantman
161 days out

Wednesday 11th
Begins the same fine weather Working
to the Westward 7 A.M. coiled down the sails
Middle & Latter part fine weather so ends
162 days out

Thursday 12th
Begins the same fine weather Working
to the Westward Moderate trades from
the Southward Lat 1-47 N Long 88 W

Remarks on board On the Line April 1860
Friday 13th

Begins the same fine weather light
trades Working to the Westward variously
Employed about the Ship
164 days out

Saturday 14th
Begins the same fine weather light
winds working to the westward variously
employed about the Ship
165 days out

Sunday 15th
Begins the same fine weather Moderate
trades steering to the Westward on the wind
Day light made the Land one of the Galapagos
Islands & at 1 P.M. the Capt and Boats crew
Went on shore fishing 3 P.M. came on board
Again with a fine lot of fish stowed to the
Eastward on the wind so ends Sunday
166 days out Lat 1-30 N Long 91-20 W

Monday 16th
Begins the same fine weather standing to
the Eastward on the wind 7 A.M. backed
to the Westward Land in sight to the South
of us employed in breaking out water
167 days out

Tuesday 17th
Begins with Moderate trades from the
S.E. steering to the Westward weather high
And hazy 5 P.M. Made the Isl. of Jarvis
About 30 miles distant Sunday shortened sail
All hands variously employed about the
Ship
168 days out
