Begins Strong Breezes With rain squalls
Working to the Eastward on the Wind under
221 days out - easy Sail

Saturday 9th
Begins the same Strong Breezes Working
To the Eastward on the Wind pulled a hog
222 days out

Sunday 10th
Begins fine weather Strong Breezes Working
To the Eastward On the Wind coasted back for
223 days out Lines

Monday 11th
Begins the same Strong Breezes Working to
The Eastward under easy Sail for rain squalls

Working to the NE Eastward all day on the
Wind saw some fin Backs one Boatstove
Sick with A sore leg Lat 2-00 N
128 days out

Saturday 16th
Begins the same Strong Breezes Standing
To the Southward On the Wind under
Easy Sail broke out for small Stores
129 day out

Sunday 17th
Begins the same Strong Breezes Standing
To the Southward on the wind under double reef
130 days out topsails

Monday 18th
Begins the same Strong Breezes with rain
squalls Standing on the Wind to the Southward
Saw plenty of fin Backs & Bay tacked to the
Northward Latter part the same
131 days out Lat 1-00 S Long 119-11 W

Tuesday 19th
Begins fine weather Moderate Breezes
Standing on the Wind to the NE Eastward all
Hands employed in breaking out fresh water out
of the grained tiers in the Main hatch & cooping
it for Oil Latter part the same
132 day out
