

Remarks on board on the Line June 1860

Wednesday 20th

Begins fine weather Moderate trades started
Saw our last Whale 30 fms and filled the
Rest of the cask with salt water & pickled
Lutts part Working to the Westward sundown
Luffed to the wind heading to the Southward
133 day out

Thursday 21st

Begins the same Working off to the Westward
Saw plenty of Fin Backs dark luffed
to the wind heading to the N^W Eastward
134 day out

Friday 22nd

Begins the same fine weather Working to
the Westward through the day 3 P M lowered
4 Boats for Black fish but without success
135 day out

Saturday 23rd

Begins the same fine weather Moderate
trades Steering S W saw every thing but
Sperm Whales. Various employed about the
Ship
136 day out

Sunday 24th

Begins fine weather Strong trades heading
to the Southward all day under double reef
To sails saw nothing today
137 day out Lat 1-01 S Long 120-02 W

Monday 25th

Begins the same Strong trades standing
to the Southward on the wind under easy
Sail Various employed about the Ship
138 day out

Tuesday 26th

Begins the same standing to the Southward
on the wind 6 P M tacked to the N^W E
Had roasted pig for dinner see n.b.
139 day Lat 3-18 S Long 121-30 W

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Wednesday 27th

Begins the same Strong Breeze standing to
the N^W Eastward on the wind Middle & Lutts same
140 day out

Thursday 28th

Begins the same Strong Breeze fine weather
Heading to the N^W Eastward on the wind
Middle & Lutts part the same
141 days out

Friday 29th

Begins fine weather Moderate Breeze stood
to the Northward until 3 P M wore Ship to
the S W saw some Fin Backs Various employed
142 Lat 10 miles S Long 120-00 W

Saturday 30th

Begins Strong Breeze fine weather Steering
S W 4 P M sailed A School of Sperm Whales
5 P M all 4 Boats struck the Waist & Starboard
Boat got foul line the Waist Boat cut & struck
Another Whale but dragged the Bow Boat Whale
Bran to the windward after the school fast with
one iron in his small could not haul up to
him sundown out from him the Starboard &
Starboard Boats captured these Whales dark
Took them alongside and lay by them all night
143 days out Lat 00-01 S Long 121-05 W

Sunday July 1st

Begins fine weather Strong Breeze daylight
Commenced cutting 10 A M finished made sail
Cruising on the wind dark commenced Boiling
144 day

Monday 2nd

Begins fine weather Moderate Breeze cruising
on the wind all hands employed in boiling &
filling the Boats 3 P M sailed A Breeze 5 miles
off gun for it but did not see it Again
145 day out
