Tuesday 3rd

Begins fine weather Moderate trades
Steering to the S W through the day 10 A M
Finished Boiling 50 bbls 2 Tail in sight
246 day

Wednesday 4th
Begins Strong Breeze fine weather cruising
On the wind 2 sail in sight 2 P M raised
A beach on our weather beam 5 miles off tack
Ship for it but did not see it again 5 P M spoke
The Ship Spartan of Nantucket 22 month out
450 bbls Whale & sperm

247 day Thursday 5th
Begins the same 8 A M raised A Large
Body of Whales going quick to the Westward
Several all 4 Boats and chased but without
Success 3 P M came on board got clines 5 sets
Lowered 2 Boats sun down the Starboard Boat
Struck 10 P M took him alongside lay by him
All night Lat 00 25 S Long 122 05 W

248 day Friday 6th
Begins the same fine weather daylight commenced
Cutting 8 A M finished made sail cruising
On the wind under easy sail so ends
249 days out

Saturday 7th
Begins the same fine weather Strong Breeze
cruising on the wind 3 A M comm Boiling
250 days out

Sunday 8th
Begins the same 7 A M finished boiling
Middle & Latter part Strong Breeze cruising
251 day out

Monday 9th
Begins the same cruising on the wind breaking
Out water in the fore hole getting ready to stem
Oil saw nothing Delay
252 days out

Tuesday 10th

Begins the same fine weather daylight
Commenced storing down did not finish heel
dark knocked off cruising on the wind
253 day out

Wednesday 11th
Begins the same fine weather Moderate
Breeze 2 sail in sight finished storing
Down 3 P M gamed with the Bark Mathew
Luce 14 month out 500 Sperm
254 days out

Thursday 12th
Begins the same fine weather Moderate
Breeze cruising on the wind 4 P M gamed
With the Spartan & Mathew Luce so ends
255 days out

Friday 13th
Begins the same fine weather
Cruising on the wind to the Southward
256 day out

Saturday 14th
Begins the same fine weather cruising
On the wind to the Northward saw nothing
257 days out

Sunday 15th
Begins the same fine weather 8 A M
Revised A School of Black fish Lowered 11
Boats the Starboard Boat struck & captured
Steering S W through the day
258 day out

Monday 16th
Begins the same fine weather Moderate
Breeze one Tail in sight Steering to the S W
Through the day saw more Black fish But
did not levels for them variously employed
259 day out
