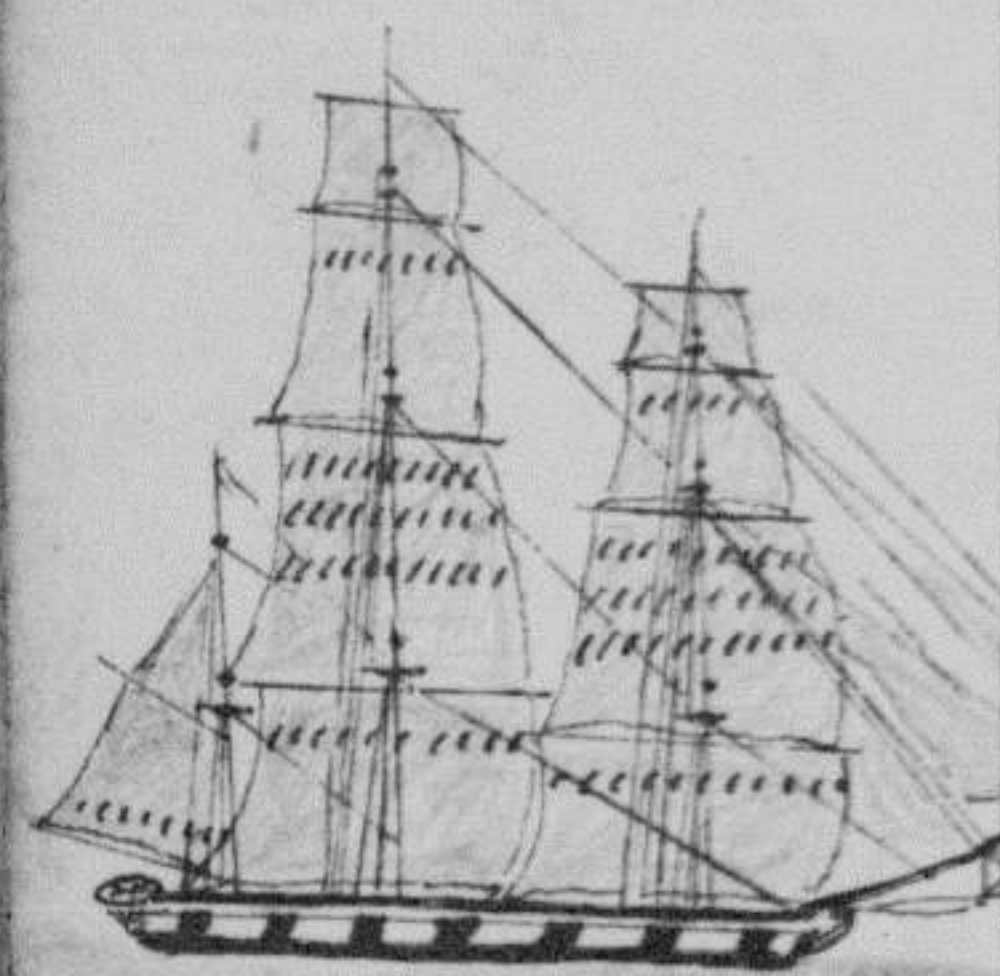


Journal of the Ship George Porter

 Lat by S E 31° 40' N

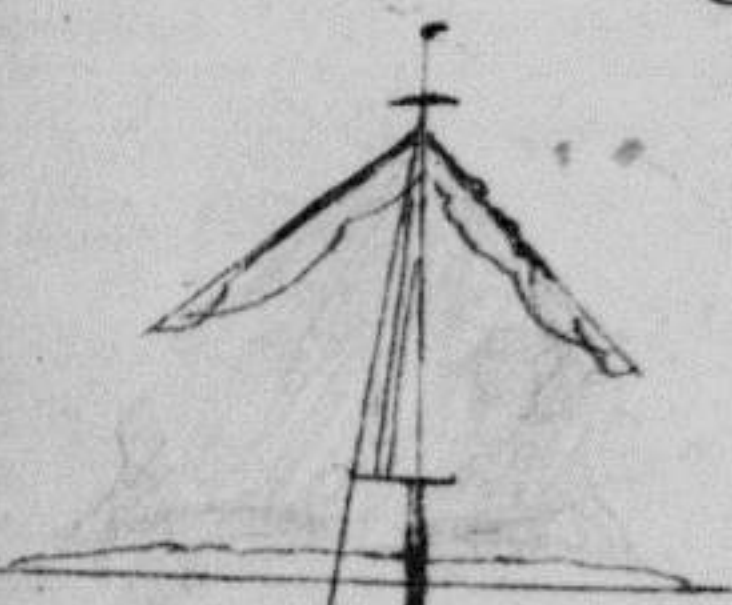
Friday May the 11

All those 24 guns strong ships from the N and passing through the channel to the S E all sail set to the West Advancing at 4 PM saw a number of frigates and Lat by the 31° 04' N

first part brisk wind from the N and passing through the channel to the S E all sail set at 4 PM hauled away the fore topgallant yard middle and latter part strong gale from the S and frequent reports of rain in the night the topmasts saw Lat by the 29° 00' N

first part strong gale from the N and passing through the channel to the S E in the night all sail set to the West Advancing at 4 PM saw all sail set to the West Advancing at 4 PM Lat by the 28° 51' N

Commenced with moderate breezes from the N and pleasant steam to the S E all sail set to the West Advancing at 4 PM saw the latter part strong wind and heavy with passing clouds all sail set to the West Advancing at 4 PM Lat by the 29° 24' N

All those 24 guns strong S E winds and heavy steam to the S E all sail set to the West Advancing at 4 PM Lat by the 29° 30' N
